## Specifics

Members of the Group Member Organizations Committee will review each application submitted and decide upon one winner for each USDF region. Committee members serving as judges will not judge nominations from GMOs to which they belong. The winners will be announced at the Board of Governors General Assembly during the Adequan/USDF Annual Convention and will receive an award. Applications are due in the USDF office no later than **August 31**<sup>st</sup>.
